



Sparky on the Spot

Training Tips 101:

When introducing your dog to their new potty for the first time, follow these tips to ensure a smooth introduction:

- Do not encourage your dog to lie down on the unit or use as a bed.
- Use the command that you normally would use when going out for potty. That could be piddles, potty, pee pee, etc. and make sure you are always re-enforcing the action with, "it's OK, it's OK"- Good girl, Good boy.
- If you are training a puppy, pick a command and stick with that command throughout the dogs life.
- Reward huge, every time they use their Sparky on the Spot. Make sure to always reward your dog away from the unit and never on it or beside it.
- The training pads that are used to line the Polyethylene tray located below the imitation turf provide a natural scent that will attract the dog to use it.
- If a little stubborn the first time, put the dog's leash on when it's that first piddle of the day or the last (when you know they have to go) and lead them to the Sparky on the Spot and give them your command, (potty, piddle, pee pee).
Using the leash will help them to associate going potty with the unit.
- Even when your dog is fully trained and using the Sparky on the Spot, remember to always reward them after every use.
Remember: A good owner is a good trainer, and your dog will respond accordingly.
